This is a <u>Cambodian dance/game</u> reserved only for very happy occasions. The two people kneeling hold long wooden poles which they pull together to close and then open. The two figures standing must be very quick jumping in and out between the poles; the object being that the poles do not touch their feet.

Doesn't it look like fun?

The long brown building with a fence around it, at the bottom, is a school. Cambodian children wear a uniform; the girls must wear a white blouse and blue skirt while the boys wear a white shirt and either blue, gray or beige short or long pants.

It is hoped that this collage has provided some interesting information of a few of the "highlights" of a Cambodian lifestyle.

At the bottom right hand corner is a sentence written in the Khmer language. It says:

"We hope you enjoy our art work of Cambodia."
