

A Typical Day In Cambodian Village

When I get up in the morning the rooster wakes me up. I walk very far to school because there is no bus to ride on. Cambodian students must wear uniforms to school.

School starts at 7:30.

My father could tell time by looking at the position of the sun. Most people in the village do not have clock or wrist watches. At night my father could look at the moon and tell time.

When I went to school we used paper and small blackboard to write on. We did not have pencils so we used sticks. First we burned the sticks in a fire until the sticks got black. Then we could write on the paper or the blackboard.
