
Dear Congressman Jones,

On November 8, 1973, the Student Bar Association of the University of Tulsa College of Law conducted an opinion poll at the law school. Of the 468 law students enrolled at our school, 208 (44%) law students voted, with the following results:

"Should the United States House of Representatives institute impeachment proceedings against President Richard M. Nixon?"

YES -- 117 votes (56.25%)
