This day came the parties by their Attornies and the Jury sworn yesterday to try the Issue in this cause appeared according to their Adjournment and having fully heard the Evidence upon their Oath do say that the Plts are free and not Slaves as by replying they have alledged & they do Assess the damages of the Plts by the occasion in the Declaration mentioned to one shilling besides their Costs Therefore It is considered by the Court that the Plts recover against the Deft their damages aforesaid in form aforesaid assessed & their Costs by them about their Suit in this behalf expended & the said Deft may be taken &c.
