

BUILD SCHOOL FOR COLORED NEXT WEEK

**Structure, Near Barracks, May
Form Nucleus for Proposed
Negro Village.**

Construction of the grammar school for colored children in East Kingsport will be started next Tuesday morning, it was announced today by City Manager L. H. Kidd.

The new school, which will be of brick, containing four rooms and which will cost about \$20,000, will be located just west of the barracks built for the Edgewood Arsenal, and will form the nucleus, it is thought, for a model village for colored people, as is contemplated in the city plan.

The school, small though it is, will be modern in every detail and is to be constructed so that it may be enlarged without detriment to its appearance. The village, according to the information concerning it now available, also is to be modern in every detail and will form a complete city in itself.

Mr. Kidd stated that the school building will be ready for occupancy by the beginning of the school term in September. Work on the other schools is progressing satisfactorily, it was further stated.
