

K. O. GRAVES CITES HIS RING CAREER

Kingsport Fighter Held the Late Tiger Flowers to a Draw—Wants Bouts

K. O. Graves, colored middle-weight champion of the south, who is residing in Kingsport this winter, has a splendid ring career over a span of seven years. During his fighting career, Graves has won 54 by the K. O. route, and 43 by decision. Twenty-six resulted in draws. He has never met defeat and has fought 123 battles against some of the leading ringmen of the United States.

Graves fought the late Tiger Flowers to a draw several years ago. He has met "Six Second" Smith, "Battling" Edwards, Dick Gans, "Fighting Bob" Lawson, Pinkey Lewis and "Battling" Mays.

The Kingsport boy hopes to fight several times during the winter. He has issued a challenge to any fighter under 175 pounds, the time and place for the bout to be agreed upon.
