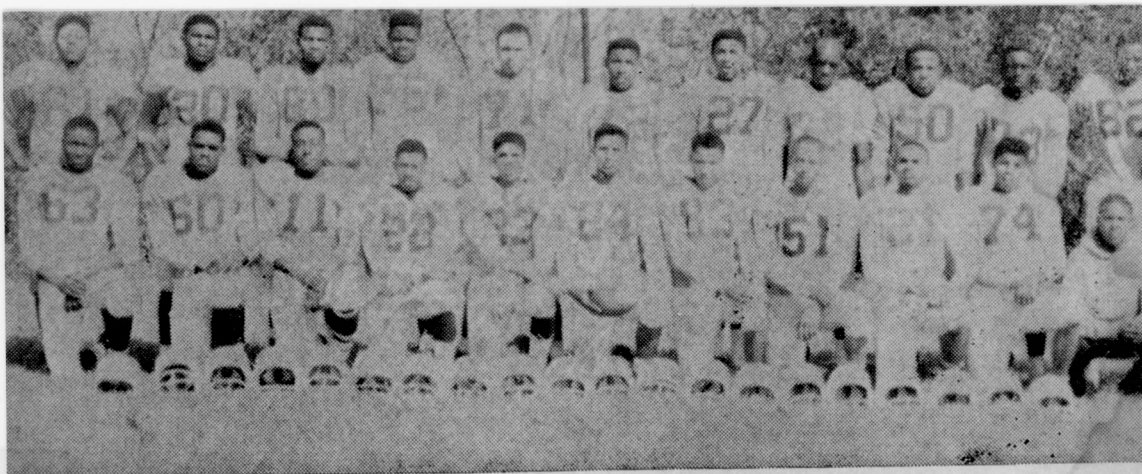
NELSON MERRY SCHOOL HAS THREE BASKETBALL TEAMS AND A FOOTBALL TEAM. THIS YEAR OF 1949-1950 HAS BEEN A WONDERFUL YEAR IN SPORTS.

THE GIRLS BASKETBALL TEAM THIS YEAR HAS SHOWN A GREAT DEAL OF COURAGE AND THE WILL TO WIN. THEY HAVE WON NINE GAMES AND LOST SEVEN INCLUDING TOURNAMENT GAMES. THE MEMBERS OF THE TEAM ARE, EDNA THOMPSON, ALMA WELLS, BARBARA PECK, HUESTA DONALDSON, HAZEL WILLIS, BETTY DONALDSON, REBA THOMAS, AND HELEN LAUDERBACK FORWARDS. 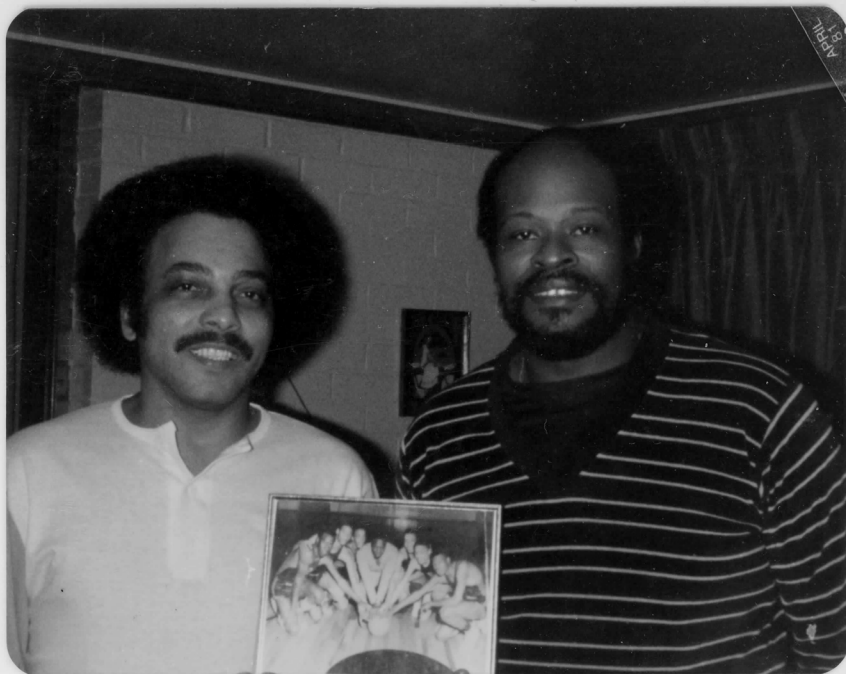

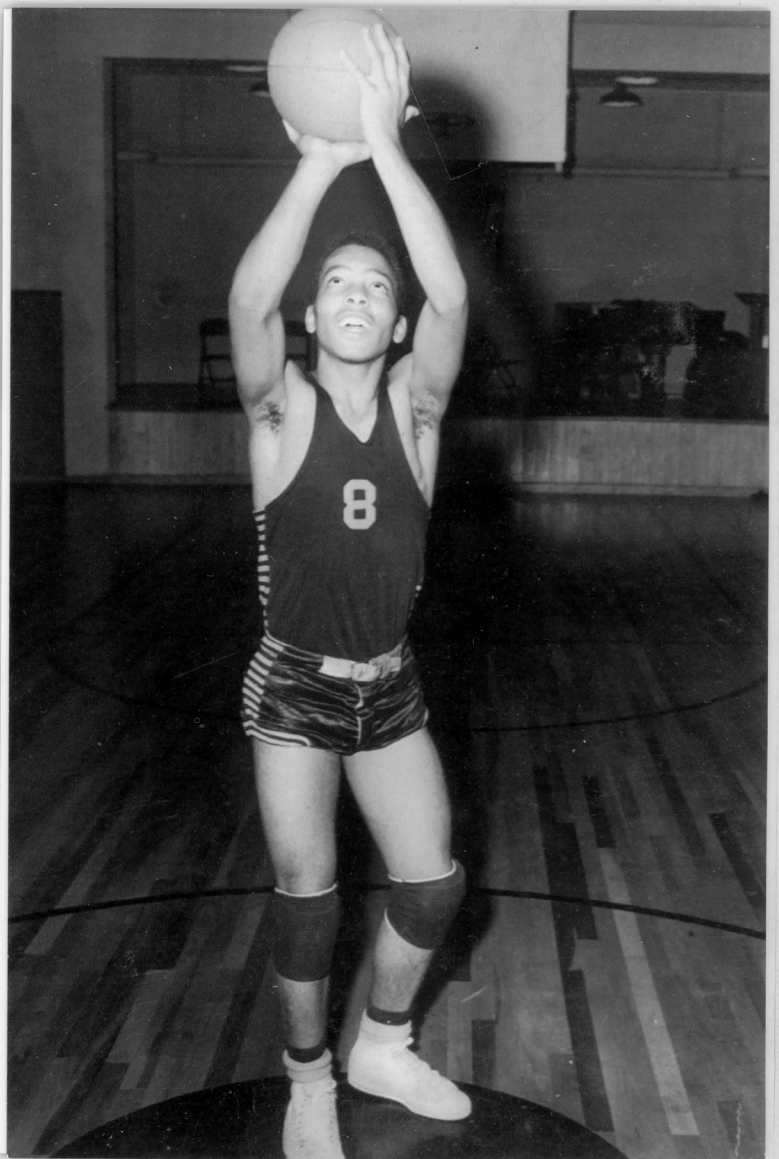
