Harvest Celebration Concert Feb. 1

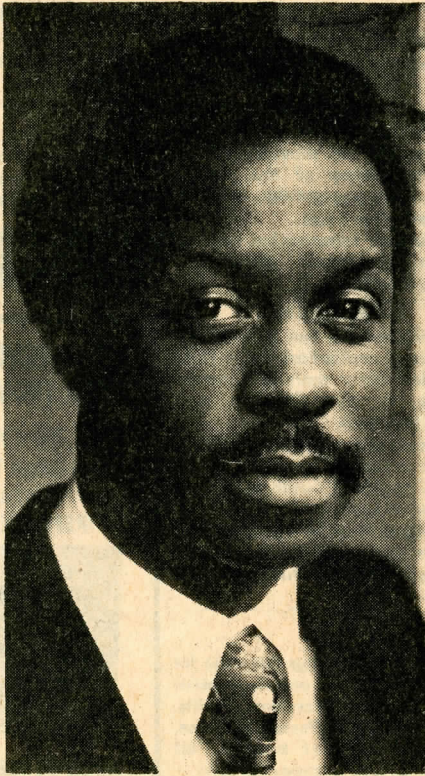
