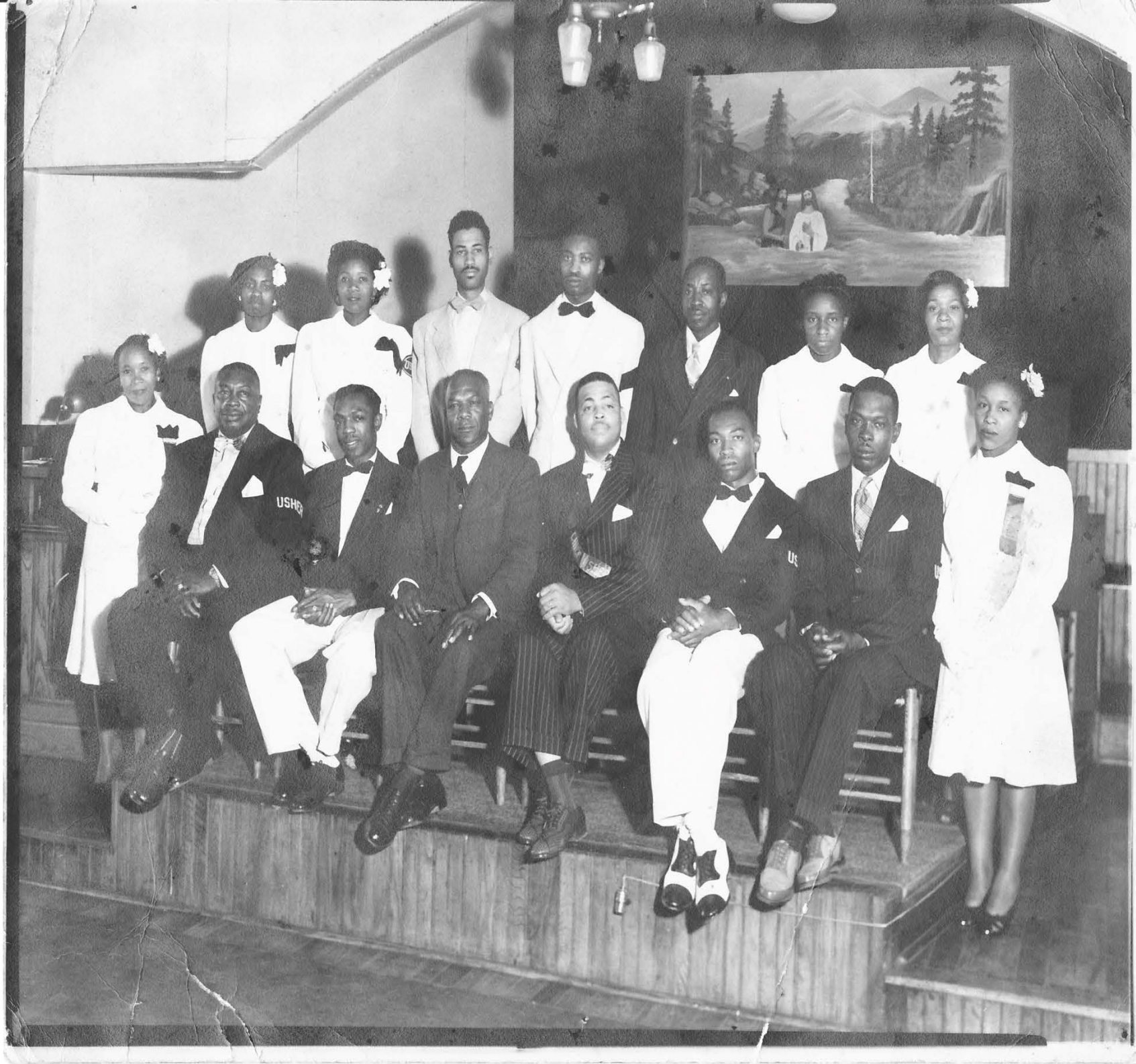

Church History

From the membership of the WILLING WORKERS CLUB emerged the body of Baptists later named the SHILOH BAPTIST CHURCH, and accepted into membership of the BETHEL DISTRICT ASSOCIATION ON JUNE 1, 1936.

Though the number was small, their determination, faith, and foresight today becomes to us a monument of their perseverance, determination and singleness of purpose.

For their sacrifices, fearlessness, foresight, ambitions and love of Christ, we are indebted for the progress twenty-five years has brought.

From the humble beginnings in a tent on Maple Street, we now view with pride our present properties and membership.

We are very proud of our departmentalized Sunday School, Senior Junior Choir; Men's Chorus; Mass Choir; and the Crusaders; Missionary Circles I and II; Usher Board; Pastor's Aid Club, and The Brotherhood.

We have purchased a Pastorium, in which the present pastor resides, the property adjoining the Church, and made repairs and improvements on the present Church building. From 13 members, we now have 193 members.



Enos Flack:

Arrived in Kingsport laying Railroad tracks from Virginia. Kingsport had just become a small city, Enos had been given a job laying water pipes along Walnut Street. Walnut Street was about the 5th area with city water around 1920. That area is where Shiloh stands now. During the 1920's the area around Walnut Street was known as the "Colored Area". Mr Enos Flack was the Grand Father to Sister Carolyn Goodwin.
