FLOODS CITY COURT

Three Negroes Arraigned This Morning on Fighting and Drunken Charges

City Judge Tom Hurst's court was attended by a large throng of the local colored element today when three members of the brunette race were brought up on charges of drunkenness and fighting.

Bill Mosser, colored, will serve a 90-day sentence on the road following his arrest by local officers last evening on charges of assault, drunkenness and public profanity. He was fined \$50 on the charges preferred but a 90-day sentence previously imposed on which he was paroled was renewed.

Moss was charged with striking Nancy Baker, colored, over the head with a quart bottle of milk. The woman was hailed into court on charges of fighting and drunkenness but was dismissed. Shorty Washington, another colored individual who happened to be mixed up in the fray, was fined \$25 on charges of drunkenness and fighting.

The arrests were made during police activities last evening.
