Lynched by a Mob.

Bristol, Tenn., June 13 .- Bob Clarke, a young mulatto, under arrest for ravishing Mrs. John Warren, was given a preliminary investigation yesterday and this morning. The evidence was wholly circumstantial. It is known that he had been trying to effect an entrance into rooms of young ladies for a month. At 1 o'clock a mob, two thousand strong, took Clarke from the city jail, carried him to the outskirts of town, and hung him with a trace chain to a chestnut tree.
