

History of the Organization

Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc., was founded January 13, 1913 on the campus of Howard University, Washington, D.C., and this year celebrates 70 years of public service. The 22 young women founders envisioned an organization established on Christian principles and dedicated to serious endeavor whose members, being of sound moral character, would be able to promote effective change and thereby, improve the quality of life in their communities.

Morristown Alumnae Chapter was chartered March 28, 1981. Its 13 founders are pledged to uphold the national program of educational development, economic development, community and international development, housing and urban development and mental health.

Since 1981, members have canvassed their neighborhoods in support of the Mothers March of Dimes; provided a yearly \$500 scholarship at Morristown College and provided other financial and moral support at the College; provided scholarships to the winner and first runner-up of the "Miss Bronze" pageant; supported the Chanber of Commerce and Central Services Christmas programs; supported the National Haitian Refugee Project; the local NAACP, Cherokee Mental Health and other civic and community projects.

In 1982-83, our efforts will be devoted to the work of Bethel Nursery and Progressive Child Care Centers; to Morristown College, to a local Teen-lift for young women ages 13-19 and other national and local projects.




MS. EDYE ELLIS


