The home of Homer Elder was located on the corner of Wesley and Clem Streets. Mrs. Biggs moved in with the Elder family and began Bible and health reform studies. From these modest beginning in 1949, grew the Seventh Day Adventist Church on Wesley Street.

The faithfulness and hard work of this group was rewarded when enough money was raised to build a proper church on Henry Street. The building was begun in 1953 and was completed in 1959.
