



### **TATE CHAPEL UNITED METHODIST CHURCH**

The Zion Methodists met in the Male Academy on Church Street in 1867 and Reverend W. H. Hellory was the pastor. Services were evidently held there until 1875 when a piece of property became available for \$50 by E. S. Rising. The land was purchased by the Trustees of Greeneville's colored Methodist Episcopal Church: Jackson Arter, Martin Lawrence, Henry Dix, Miles Morris, and Lee Cannon.

The first building consisted of a sanctuary and a Ladies Parlor. Tate Chapel Methodist Episcopal Church merged with the Methodist Church in 1939.

### **HOUSTON CHAPEL CHURCH**

The property for Warrensburg Houston Chapel was purchased on February 10, 1909 for its 40 members. The church also also maintained a cemetery and a school, which had been established in the 1870s. In 1978, the membership had dwindled to 22 people so the church merged with Tate Chapel.

In 2006 a fire heavily damaged the interior of Tate Chapel but fourteen months later, and after a successful restoration, the congregation rededicated their historic church.

## HOUSTON CHAPEL CEMETERY

Located on Easterly Road near South Mohawk Road, Warrensburg, Tennessee

Tom Leach read this cemetery on August 25, 2006. He reported there were over a dozen limestone markers which have weathered to where they can no longer be read. Some also look like "natural" field stones.
