My Darling Wife

Hi honey. How is my ever so sweet wife and baby feeling? Fine I hope, as for me I'm feeling fine except that I miss you so very much. That's because I love you. We took some pictures last week but only two came out any good so I'm sending you one that describes my tailor made under clothes. Tomorrow we are going to try and take some pictures of the kitchen here on maneuvers. I hope we get away with it. I came back to camp today for about four hours. I had to make six hundred cookies for the boys. By the way my shipping orders have been changed to the 31st of this month and I found out for sure that I am going to Texas. Honey

in your letter of the 12<sup>th</sup> you said  
you saving your money to buy me a  
gift that you <sup>know</sup> I want. And as soon  
as they start making them you going  
to buy one. What on earth do you  
expect to buy me? How in kind of  
puzzled about that unknown gift you  
intend to buy me. How about throwing  
a hint, baby. So you thought Bambino  
baby was real cute. How much did  
the baby weigh? you certainly can  
get around those hospitals can't you?  
So you <sup>have</sup> been writing me a letter  
without a dress or have you. What  
makes you think I'd blow up if  
I saw you without a dress. Honey  
I've been away from you so long that  
if I seen you without any clothes at  
all (I'd think you were beautiful) How  
Honey in your letter I got today there  
is something I didn't quite understand

and that's about you sending some money  
to Kate that works at the Buckeye in  
Bellare. Did you mean that you owed  
her some money and that you paid her  
back or do you mean that the money you  
sent her was the money you drew from  
the bank when we were in Texas? By  
the way honey what time do you start  
working in the evening? In case I would  
have to call I wouldn't know the best time

Thanks for telling what to do when  
lighting candles in church. I thought it  
best to find out first so I wouldn't  
make a fool of myself. I don't think  
I'll get a chance to go to church this  
Sunday because we will still be on man-  
euvers but I'll go as soon as possible.

When I get to the other camp I'm  
supposed to go I'm going to try and  
get a leather club gang so I can start

making bags again (I mean purses not women)  
I rather enjoy that kind of work because  
its a very good past time and I'm getting  
something out of it. Honey I better close  
now because I want to write a few  
lines to my folks at home. I dont  
think I told you this before but when  
I didn't write for such a long time I  
got a letter for Orenta begging me to  
write to my mother because she's been  
crying every day. So I thought it over  
and decided to write. I told them how  
sorry I was but that I had reasons  
for not writing and I told them what  
they were. They said that they were  
sorry for all that has happened and  
that they would like to forget it  
all. I also mentioned that I cashed  
my bonds and sent you the money  
and that you put the money in our  
name and not your familys. I told

em that since they wouldn't give us  
ny money I had to cash the bonds  
ecause I wouldn't feel right without  
ring you and the baby all I can  
nd if they don't see fit to give us  
he money now they can shove it, be-  
ause the only thing I'm sorry about  
that I saved some of the money in-  
stead of spending it. Because if I didn't  
ave any money we wouldn't of had all  
here hard feelings. Honey all I can say  
now is that try to get along with  
what we have now and when I get  
t of this army I'll give <sup>you</sup> every thing in  
ny power. By the way honey this  
may make you mad but I thought  
d tell you about it, then you can  
side for yourself right now. They  
entioned the fact that you still  
aren't called them mom & dad. I'm  
at asking you to, that's enterly up to  
you

you. Although I do think it would be  
nice if you could get in the habit.  
Darling have I ever told you that  
you're the most wonderful wife in the  
world and the kin the luckiest guy?  
is to be able to have somebody to love  
like you. And if my predictions are  
right about the war being over by Oct. 21<sup>st</sup>  
it won't be long and I'll be home with  
you and our baby for ever. I'll close  
now darling saying "I'll get by as long  
as I have you because I love you."
