24 Albert is an excellent example of the gable-roofed 2 1/2 story Queen Anne built throughout the Highlands in the 1890s. A turned spindle porch is characteristic.

24 Albert was the first house built on Albert Street, which was platted in the early 1890s primarily by Caleb Smith. Ath the time of its construction, there were few houses south of Forrest Street.
