ADDITIONAL HISTORICAL INFORMATION

Numerous buildings were located here on 19th century maps and atlases, most frame and some brick, including a home for elderly women at the corner of Tremont Street (this street is no longer present) and Moody Street. Other uses of buildings on this site in 1882 included dwellings, tenements, a barber and a grocery store. The same diverse group of buildings appears on atlases through 1936. On the 1977 atlas, the land is vacant.
