The bill establishing The Olmsted Historic Site in Brookline comes up for markup in the Energy Committee this morning.

As introduced, Section 3 of S.495 would authorize such sums as may be necessary for the acquisition and development of the site. The proposed amendment to Section 3 would include specific authorization figures:

\$ 514,000 - archival collection

200,000 - interim development costs

1,230,000 - preservation and management of archival collection (total 5 year cost)

372,000 - land and improvements (appraisal value)

There are five amendments to S.495 suggested by the Subcommittee.

- 1. Require map reference.
- 2. Require Secretary to complete general management plan within 3 years.
- 3. Require Secretary to submit report within 1 year on protection arrangements.
- 4. Authorize Secretary to enter into cooperative agreements for management of archives.
- 5. Include authorization figures as above.

I think the skids are basically greased on this now that archive costs are settled.
