- * THE U.S. SENATE IS IN RECESS Paul will be in Boston through April 26th.
- * Paul is again the principle cosponsor of the so-called "SUNRISE" bill. S. 866 was introduced in the Senate by Senator Baucus. The bill would improve Congressional oversight of Federal programs by requiring greater specificity in setting program objectives, by requiring continuing information on the extent to which programs are achieving their stated objectives, by requiring periodic review of new authorizations of budget authority and tax expenditures, etc. - referred to the Government Affairs Committee.
- * Energy Committee will start mark-up on the Department of Energy budget on May 4th and go through the 15th.
- * Paul is a cosponsor of Senator Riegle's resolution, S.J. Res. 40 to designate April 26th as "National Recognition Day for Veterans of the Vietnam Era".
- * Paul is a cosponsor of S.J. Res. 60 to authorize and request the President to designate the week of May 3 through May 9 as "National Physical Fitness and Sports for All Week".
- * Paul was a cosponsor of the resolution passed by the Senate, by voice vote on April 2nd, to commend Agents McCarthy and Parr and officer Delahanty for their unselfish courage and patriotism during the recent attempt on the life of the President of the United States.
- * Paul is a cosponsor of S.J. Res. 47 to authorize and request the President to issue a proclamation designating the week beginning May 10th as "National Small Business Week".
- * Paul is a cosponsor of a resolution (S.J. Res. 22) to make March 16th of each year "Freedom of Information Day".
