Dear Chairman Dingell:

I am writing to supply some clarification of one point in your letter of January 9, 1978 to Chairman Hendrie: the reference in the 102 document to the packet of information brought by the CIA to the February, 1976 briefing and NRC's lack of interest in it. I did not recall such a packet and first became aware of it when I reviewed the 102 document at Mr. Gossick's request (memo attached) after it had been requested by Dr. Henry Myers of the Interior subcommittee staff. I replied the same day, July 19, 1977, expressing an interest in its contents (memo to Lee V. Gossick attached).

Mr. Gossick referred me to Mr. Eagle. I spoke with Mr. Eagle, who was still with the NRC at that time. He reported to me that the CIA material was not traceable as the official who had briefed the NRC had by then left the Agency.
