CANOLING

Junction of I-95 and Neponset St. between Norwood and Canton
a) Behind the Sunoco Station or
b) Across from the Sunoco Station on the old Norwood Airport

Greenlodge St. in Canton near the junction of I-95 and route 128,
(Come along Greenlodge St. from route 138 in Canton.)

Senator Tsongas is scheduled to be with us in Milton at 2 P.M. to join us in a nature walk along our river bank.

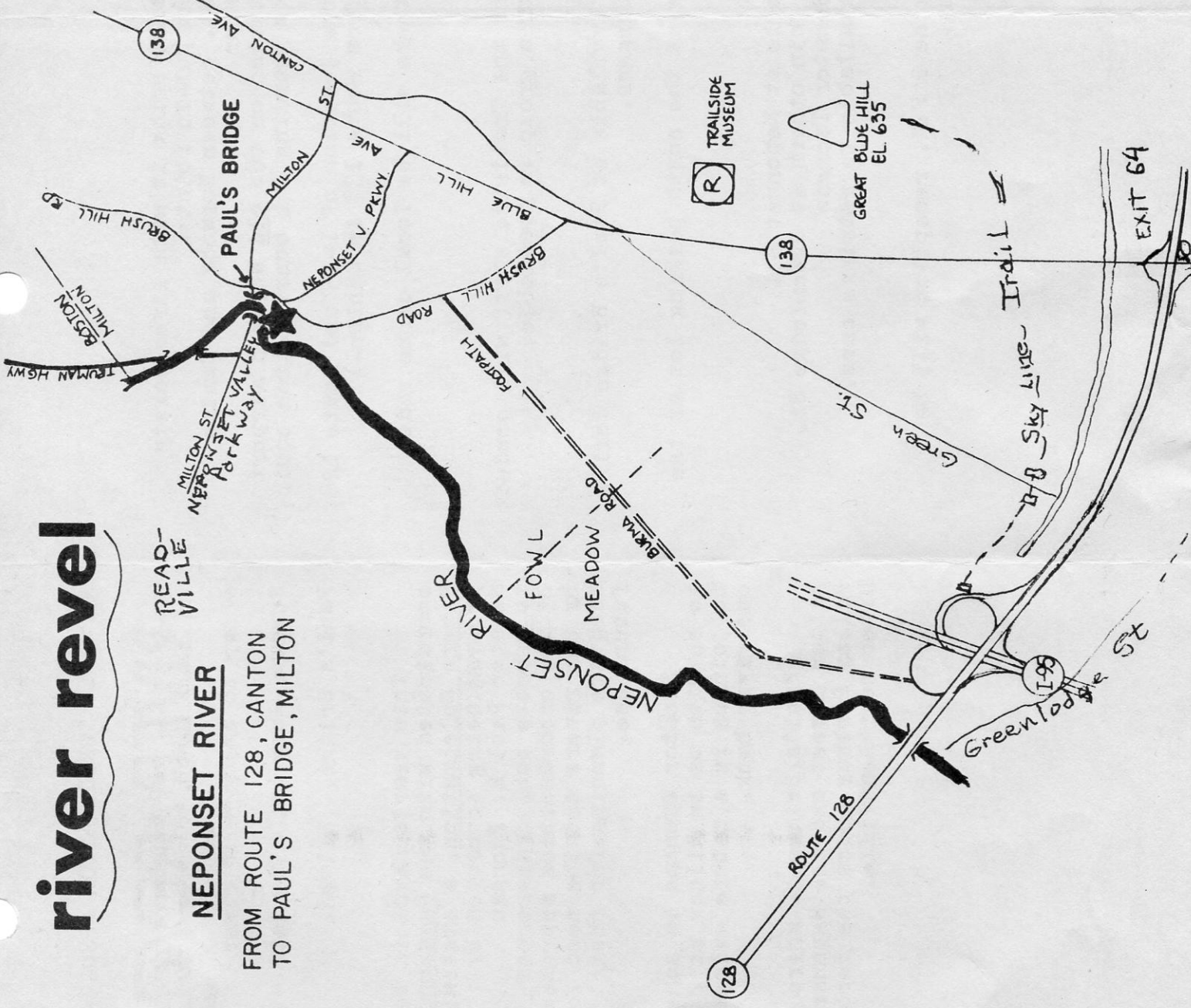
Paul's Bridge is where Milton Street and the Neponset Valley Parkway cross the Neponset River near Readville.
