

A BILL

For the relief of Kenneth C. Foster.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
2 of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That  
3 Kenneth C. Foster, Disbursing Officer, 27th Finance Section,  
4 NATO/SHAPE Support Group (United States), Chievres, Belgium,  
5 is relieved of all liability to the United States for the sum  
6 of \$25,145.71, which liability is a result of the theft of  
7 120,000 francs of public funds by a person unknown in or  
8 between Paris, France, and Chievres, Belgium, on or about  
9 March 20, 1978, after the said Kenneth C. Foster, while  
10 acting as Deputy Finance and Accounting Officer, 27th Finance  
11 Section, NATO/SHAPE Support Group (United States), Chievres,  
12 Belgium, had delivered such funds to the United States  
13 Embassy in Paris, France, for delivery by courier to United  
14 States authorities in Belgium.
