- * The Senate Energy Committee Subcommittee on Energy Regulation is holding hearings tommorrow on amendments to the Powerplant and Industrial Fuel Use Act.
- * The Senate Foreign Relations Committee will hold a <u>second</u> hearing on Monday on the confirmation of Chester Crocker to be Assistant Secretary of State for Africa. This additional hearings is at the insistance of Sen. Jesse Helms.
- * The Senate Energy Committee Subcommittee on Public Lands begins hearings today on S.842, the RARE II Review Act of 1981. This is the Hayakawa bill mentioned in earlier <u>Legislative Alerts</u>. This bill is likely to become a MAJOR ENVIRONMENTAL ISSUE.
