A BILL

For the relief of Makoto Yabe and Yasuko Yabe.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
2 of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That,
3 notwithstanding paragraph (14) of section 212 (a) of the
4 Immigration and Nationality Act, for purposes of such Act,
5 Makoto Yabe and Yasuko Yabe shall be held and considered to
6 have been lawfully admitted to the United States for
7 permanent residence as of the date of the enactment of this
8 Act upon payment of the required visa fees. Upon the granting
9 of permanent residence to such aliens as provided for in this
10 Act, the Secretary of State shall instruct the proper officer
11 to reduce by the proper number, during the current fiscal
12 year or the fiscal year next following, the total number of
13 immigrant visas which are made available to natives of the
14 country of the aliens' birth under section 203 (a) of the
15 Immigration and Nationality Act or, if applicable, the total
16 number of immigrant visas which are made available to natives
17 of the country of the aliens' birth under section 202 of such
18 Act.
