Mr. TSONGAS introduced the following joint resolution; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

JOINT RESOLUTION

Designating Sunday, August 1, 1982, as "National Day of Peace".

Whereas all Americans need to reflect on the prospect of peace among the peoples of the world; and

Whereas a time should be set aside when people of all shades of opinion can come together in unity to consider the possibilities for peaceful coexistence: Now, therefore, be it

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That Sunday, August 1, 1982, is designated as "National
4 Day of Peace" and the President is requested to issue a pro-
5 clamation calling upon the people of the United States to ob-
6 serve such day with appropriate ceremonies and activities.
