TRANSITION COMMITTEE MTG HELD ON 3/3

ASSIGNMENTS  
THE TRANSFER OF THE HOURLY WAGE PERSONNEL HAS BEEN COMPLETED. THERE ARE 425 Hourly EMPLOYEES. ALL OF THESE WERE OFFERED TRANSFERS. TEN PERSON DID NOT ACCEPT, 3 OPTED FOR RETIREMENT, 3 RESIGNED VOLUNTARILY AND 4 WERE OFFERED ~~DOWN GRADES~~ IN PAY AND ELECTED PAY-OFFS.

OF THE 424 REMAINING 304 WILL BE TRANSFERRED TO BILLERICA AND 110 TO LAWRENCE IN BILLERICA 296 WILL BE ASSIGNED TO THE FIRST SHIFT, FROM 6:45 TO 3:15 OR 7:00 TO 3:30. EIGHT WILL BE ASSIGNED TO THE SECOND SHIFT. IN LAWRENCE 85 WILL BE ASSIGNED TO THE ~~FIRST~~ FIRST SHIFT, FROM 7:30 TO 4:00 AND 25 TO THE SECOND SHIFT.

~~THE TRANSFERS TO THE CHOICE OF THE~~  
LOCATION, EITHER BILLERICA OR LAWRENCE, WAS OFFERED TO EACH EMPLOYEE ON A SENIORITY BASIS AND ACCORDING TO PUSCHEN all but 10 PERSONS AT THE MOST WERE ASSIGNED TO THE LOCATION THEY DESIRED.

CONCERNING bus SERVICE , THERE THE EMPLOYEES WERE ASKED DURING THE TRANSFER INTERVIEW IF THEY WERE STILL INTERESTED IN ~~THE~~ UTILIZING THE 90 DAY FREE BUS SERVICE OF THE 296 GOING TO BILLERICA , SO STILL WANTED BUSING AND OF THE 85 TO LAWRENCE 60 EXPRESSED INTEREST . THIS IS A DECREASE ~~IN~~ FROM THE NUMBER THAT WAS OBTAINED FROM THE SURVEY DONE A COUPLE OF WEEKS AGO.

THE ~~90~~ FIRST 90 DAY CONTRACT WILL OR HAS GONE OUT TO BID. DUSCHENE WILL INFORM US OF WHETHER OR NOT LOCAL CARRIERS WERE AWARDED THE CONTRACT IN ORDER THAT P. MARTINEK ~~OF THE LRTA~~ WILL KNOW WHAT APPROACH TO TAKE WITH VOELL AND TROMBLEY FOR SERVICE AFTER THE 90 DAY PERIOD.

DUSCHENE INDICATED THAT THERE WOULD PROBABLY BE A NEED FOR APPROXIMATELY 50 PARKING SPACES AT THE PICK-UP LOCATION AFTER THE 90 DAY PERIOD. D. COFFEY ON BEHALF OF THE CITY MANAGER OFFERED TO RESERVE A PORTION OF EITHER THE WARREN ST OR DUTTON ST LOTS. BOTH LOCATIONS HAVE .25 / 10 HR. METERS. DUSCHENE DIDN'T APPEAR TO BE VERY EXCITED BUT HE WILL INQUIRE ABOUT HONEYWELL MAKING AN ARRANGEMENT TO PAY RATHER THAN THE EMPLOYEES. COFFEY INDICATED THAT THE CITY ~~MAY~~ MIGHT NEGOTIATE THE COST W/ HONEYWELL.

AS AN ALTERNATIVE, SOUSA FROM THE CHAMBER SAID THAT DEMOCALIS OFFERED SEVERAL SIGHTS. THE ONE WITH THE MOST POTENTIAL SEEKS TO BE THE RTE. 3 CINEMA CITY ~~LAW~~ LOT ON THE LOWELL CHELMSFORD LINE.

OF THE 161 DUSCHENE ESTIMATES THAT APPROXIMATELY 150 WILL BE ASSIGNED TO BILLERICA AND 11 TO LAWRENCE. MOREOVER, HE FEELS THAT THERE WILL BE A MINIMAL LAY-OFF OF THIS GROUP IF ANY.
