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CONFORMING AMENDMENTS

1. Amendment:

In Title IV, "National Conservation Areas" strike entire title and renumber subsequent titles accordingly.

Explanation: Eliminates category of BLM administered units which have been established in this amendment as national wildlife refuges.

2. Amendment:

Polcupine

(a) In Title V, strike section 501 in its entirety and renumber subsequent sections according.

(b) In Title V, in Section 502(b), page 417, line 19, change the period to a comma and add "Provided further, that the expertise of the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service shall be utilized in development of a management plan for this Copper River unit and any subsequent revisions of that plan, and that such plan or its revisions shall be coordinated with national and regional Fish and Wildlife Service management plans and programs for the migratory species using this unit."

On page 417, strike line 20, and insert in lieu thereof the following: "shall only be permitted in a manner compatible, as that term is used under the Refuge Administration Act, 16 U.S.C. 668dd (d)(1), with the protection."

- (c) In Title V, amend section 504 to delete "the Porcupine National Forest and"

Explanation: Deletes references to the Porcupine National Forest which is established as parts of the Arctic and Yukon Flats National Wildlife Refuges and provides for U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service coordination in management of the Copper River Unit of the Chugach National Forest.

3. Amendment:

- (a) In Title VI, amend section 602 to include:

"(38) Beaver Creek, Alaska - The segment of the main stem from the vicinity of the Bear and Champion Creeks downstream to its exit from the northeast corner of township 12 north, range 6 east, Fairbanks meridian within the Yukon Flats National Wildlife Refuge; to be administered by the Secretary of the Interior."

"(40) Kanektok, Alaska - That portion, from its source, within the boundaries of the Togiak National Wildlife Refuge; to be administered by the Secretary of the Interior."

"(41) Kisaralik, Alaska - That portion, from its source, within the boundaries of the Yukon Delta National Wildlife Refuge; to be administered by the Secretary of the Interior."

"(42) Nowitna, Alaska - That portion from the point where the river crosses the west limit of township 18 south, range 22 east, Kateel River meridian, to its confluence with the Yukon River within the boundaries of the Nowitna National Wildlife Refuge; to be administered by the Secretary of the Interior."

"(43) Porcupine, Alaska - That portion within the boundaries of the Arctic and Yukon Flats National Wildlife Refuges; to be administered by the Secretary of the Interior."

"(45) Sheenjek, Alaska - That portion, from its source, within the boundaries of the Arctic and Yukon Flats National Wildlife Refuges; to be administered by the Secretary of the Interior."

(b) In Title VI, section 603, delete paragraph 43 and renumber subsequent paragraphs accordingly.

(c) In Title VI, section 604(a), delete subparagraphs numbered 79 and 80, 82 and 84 and renumber other subparagraphs accordingly. Amend numbers in subsequent paragraph (b)(4) to include only the appropriate remaining subparagraph numbers.

(d) In Title VI, section 605(a), amend to read "and (37) through (47) in units of the National Wildlife Refuge System." Delete "Beaver Creek" in subsections (b) and (d).

Explanation: Identifies wild rivers as being within national wildlife refuges established or expanded by Title III of this amendment.

4. Amendment:

In Title IX, section 906(d)(i), amend last sentence to insert "validly" between "previously" and "selected."

Explanation: Clarifies that the automatic conveyance of State entitlement under this section applies only to those previous selections that were validly filed.

5. Amendment:

In Title X, delete sections 1001, 1002, 1004, 1005 and 1006. Renumber remaining sections appropriately.

Explanation: Deletes the North Slope lands study.

6. Amendment:

(a) In Title X, section 1008(a): first sentence, delete "not subject to the study required in section 1001 of this Act." Second sentence, add a period after "leasing" and delete the remainder of the sentence.

(b) In Title X, section 1009(a), delete "the Mineral Leasing Act of 1920" and insert in lieu thereof "the provisions of section 304 of this Act."

Explanation: Conforms this Title to provisions of Title III of this amendment with regard to oil and gas leasing.

7. Amendment:

In Title XII, delete section 1203.

Explanation: Refuge cooperative agreement provisions have been moved to Title III.

8. Amendment:

In Title XIII, section 1301, delete "the National Wildlife Refuge System and."

Explanation: Refuge comprehensive planning provisions have been moved to Title III.

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9. Amendment:

In Title XIII, section 1315, subparagraph (e), third sentence, amend to read "the House Committee on Interior and Insular Affairs or Merchant Marine and Fisheries and the Senate Committee on Energy and Natural Resources or Environment and Public Works as appropriate,".

Explanation: Appropriate House and Senate committees with oversight of refuge operations are added to cabin construction review section.

10. Amendment:

In Title XIII, amend section 1323(b) to read "selections made on November 14, 1978,".

Explanation: Technical correction of incorrect date.

11. In Title XIII, add the following new section:

"Section 1325. Tetlin National Wildlife Refuge Exchange.

Within one year after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary and the State shall effect an exchange of lands within the Tetlin National Wildlife Refuge. In this exchange, the State shall relinquish all claims (including land selections filed under Section 6(b) of the Alaska Statehood Act) for up to forty-six

thousand and eighty acres of lands selected by the State prior to November 14, 1978, within the refuge for an equivalent acreage of Federal lands north of the Alcan Highway within the Tetlin National Wildlife Refuge, which shall be conveyed to the State as though conveyed under the Statehood Act. Such lands relinquished by the State shall become part of the Tetlin National Wildlife Refuge. This exchange shall become effective upon the execution of all documents necessary to accomplish the exchange."

12. In Title XII, add the following new section:

"Section 1326. Yukon Flats National Wildlife Refuge Agricultural Use.

Nothing in this Act or other existing law shall be construed as necessarily prohibiting or mandating the development of agricultural potential within the Yukon Flats National Wildlife Refuge pursuant to existing law. Any such development permitted within the Yukon Flats National Wildlife Refuge shall be designed and conducted in such a manner as to minimize to the maximum extent possible any adverse effects of the natural values of the unit."

13. In Title XIII, add the following new section:

"Section 1327. Terror Lake Hydroelectric Project in Kodiak National Wildlife Refuge.

Nothing in this Act or the National Wildlife Refuge System Administration Act of 1966 (16 U.S.C. 668dd) shall be construed as necessarily prohibiting the construction of the Terror Lake Hydroelectric Project within the Kodiak National Wildlife Refuge."
