Dear Secretary General:

This letter is to convey to you our deep concern for the three men of the so-called Leningrad Group who still remain in prison, and to ask for the early release of Aleksei Murzhenko, Yuri Federov and Iosif Mendelevich, on the grounds of justice as well as humanitarian concern.

One of the original twelve defendants, Sylva Zalmanson, was released in 1974. Israel Zalmanson was released upon completion of his term in 1978. In April 1979, Anatoly Altman, Hillel Butman, Lieb Khnokh, Wolf Zalmanson, and Boris Penson were freed. Mark Dymshitz and Eduard Kuznetsov were part of the prisoner exchange which took place last May.

Compelling arguments exist for the release of the three remaining prisoners. The health of these men is deteriorating rapidly. Because of his religious beliefs Mendelevich, an Orthodox Jew, must subsist on a diet of less than 1200 calories a day. Federov has already served nine years of the severe sentence which he received.

In appealing for your clemency towards these three men, we urge you to heed the appeal voiced by Murzhenko at the Leningrad Trials: " I ask the Court to sentence me to a term which would leave me some hope for happiness, for my future and that of my family. "

Your serious consideration of this request will be greatly appreciated.
