Since Paul was in Boston and/or California until the nineteenth of the month, the Press Report from Washington for April will be briefer than usual.

Paul has local and national media exposure on three major issues of national importance this month. They were:

1. Nuclear Freeze/Ground Zero: The MacNeil Lerher Report, articles in the Globe, AP Radio, CBS Radio, most Boston Radio and TV stations.
2. Falklands: Quoted in NY Times, Washington Post, Boston Globe, CBS Radio, Local Boston and Washington DC TV and Radio stations.
3. Reagan Budget: NBC Today Show, Local D.C. and Boston stations, AP Radio, etc.

Other issues which received coverage: Weinberger on Defense, photo session for Mother Jones Cover story, Chicago Sun -Times interview on the economy, PBS special taping on the economy and taxation, ERA reintroduction, East Timor, the arena, and El Salvador.
