A BILL

To confer citizenship posthumously on Corporal Wladyslaw Staniszewski.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 3 That Corporal Wladyslaw Staniszewski, a national of Great 4 Britain, who was killed in action on July 7, 1967, in the 5 Republic of Vietnam while serving in the United States 6 Marine Corps shall be held and considered to have been a 7 citizen of the United States at the time of his death.
