RE: Co-Sponsorship of Bills: for the information of the Washington
and Fifth District staffs.

Congressman Tsongas has agreed to co-sponsor the following piece of legislation:

53. Land-Use Bill.

Introduced by Congressman Morris Udall (D-Ariz). The bill would establish a Federal grant program for States desiring to develop a land use program to deal with the problems of uncontrolled growth. State land use programs developed under this Act would focus on land use decisions of more than local concern involving key facilities, areas of critical State concern, large-scale subdivisions and developments of regional impact. The bill also provides land use planning policies and guidelines for the public lands and a study of the planning needs for Indian lands.
