- 11/16 - South Shore Chamber of Commerce Business Expo, 150 attended.
- 11/18 - Kelco Metal Products, Inc. of Rockland. Employs 100. Grey Perry, Pres. Makes brass, copper & alloy mill products.
- Norfolk Conveyor Co., Cohasset, employs 125 making mult-use and custom conveyors for manufacturing plants including auto industry. Sales way down due to low capital goods spending. Products liability law major issue.
- 11/19 - Lunch with JQ, John Sower and Diane Mwanyoha of National Development Council. Discussed their Small Business training program and a conference sponsored by PET, and other issues.
- 11/21 - Attended meeting of ACTION Committee of Acushnet, a citizens group. They had distributed 450 flyers promoting my visit and got about 45 to attend on a Sunday night. Gave them status of Peckham Road Project & answered questions. Have sent followup letters to Committee and Selectmen in lieu of attendance at another meeting on Dec. 6.
- Dropped by Mayor Markey's testimonial at Venus DeMilo in Swansea. Sat with Mayor Viveiros and Mayor Johnson of Taunton.
- 11/22 - Malden Redevelopment Authority meeting on current UDAG projects: an office building and a condo project in downtown Malden.
- 11/23 - Met with Robert Danforth, Pres., Litecontrol Corp., of Hanson, employs 100, making fluorescent lighting fixtures. Involved in Dukakis campaign.
- Met with Armand Zildjian, Pres. of Zildjian Cymbals Co., of Norwell, employs 75 making cymbals. Assisting with export trading co. info and trade problems.
 - Met with Ron Ferrera, Gen. Mgr., Rumford Litho Inc. of Abington, printers for catalogues and magazines, employing 99.
 - Met with John Baird, Pres., Halliday Lithograph Corp., of Hanover, employing 950. Pleased with PET copyright law vote; opposes Dukakis and will not expand in state. Overall tax burden a greater factor than any federal action.

- Met with Larry Fox, VP Finance, & John Ladge, Pres. of Hermetite Corp. of Avon employing 215 making hermetically sealed transistors, diodes, etc. Assisting with SBA 503 equipment/expansion loan through Bay Colony.
 - Met with Sven Vaule, Jr., Pres. of Jones & Vining Corp., of Braintree, employing 1000, of which 250 are in Leominster, Salem and here, making plastic shoe lasts and PVC & urethane shoe soles.
