Sec. 110 Assistance to Units of Local Government

- (a) A state receiving financial assistance under this Act shall make available to units of local government and regional councils not less than 10 percentum of the annual state allocation for the purpose of implementing activities pursuant to the coordinated management plan required under Sec. 106(b)(1) of this Act.
- (b) No grant may be made under this section unless the applicant has submitted concurrently to the Governor and the Secretary, an application which includes a community energy strategy that shall be consistent with the related requirements of the State energy plan and which shall consider --

assurances that an opportunity has been provided to receive public comment and that such comment has been considered in the development of the community energy strategy.

- (c) Subject to the availability of funds, such grants shall be made by the Governor on the basis of competition among the applicants within that State, based on --
 - (1) the technical capability of such units of local government and regional councils to administer and implement such activities;
 - (2) the potential for significantly reducing demand for nonrenewable sources of energy;
 - (3) to consistency of the community energy strategy with the State energy plan and the intent of this Act.
- (d) The Governor shall approve an application within 90 days of receipt and shall obligate grants made pursuant to such applications with 60 days of approval of such application.

(e) Any application disapproved or not acted upon by the Governor, together with any reasons thereof, shall be transmitted to the Secretary for review and may be overruled or decided by the Secretary within 60 days of receipt of such transmittal.

(f) No grant may be made under this section unless the applicant provides funds and/or in-kind contribution equal to 20 percentum of the grant.
