- * The Senate is today returning to consideration of S.1196, the International Security and Development Cooperation Act.
- * Highlights of Paul's schedule:

- * The vote in the full Senate on the AWACs sale disapproval will be held on Wednesday, October 28 before 5 P.M.
- * The Foreign Relations Committee will hold hearings today on the Protocol to the Agreement on Importation of Educational, Scientific, and Cultural Materials.
- * The Energy Committee will hold joint hearings today with the Subcommittee on Nuclear Regulation on S.1606, the bill to provide for the cleanup of Three Mile Island.
- * The Energy Committee will tomorrow begin mark-up of the nuclear waste bill.
- * The Standby Oil Controls bill is expected to be on the Senate floor soon, maybe this week.
- * The Clean Water Act Amendments will be considered on the floor soon. S.1716 would amend the Act's sewerage treatment grants program to gradually reduce the federal share and to target to projects providing the greatest improvements in water quality. The bill focuses funding toward the older cities of the Northeast and away from growing Sunbelt areas.
- * The Judiciary Committee is holding hearings on SJ Res110, SJ Res17, SJ Res18 and SJ Res 19---Constitutional Amendments on abortion. Hearings were held yesterday and will continue November 4.
