A BILL

To amend the Export Administration Act of 1979 to terminate certain export controls imposed on December 30, 1981, and June 22, 1982.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

That Section 6 of the Export Administration Act of 1979 (50 U.S.C. App. 2405) is amended by adding at the end thereof the following new subsection:

"(1) TERMINATION OF CERTAIN CONTROLS. - Those export controls imposed under this section on December 30, 1981, and June 22, 1982, on goods or technology shall not be effective on or after the date of enactment of this subsection."
