STUDDS TO HOST FEDERAL PROCUREMENT AND EXPORT SEMINAR

WASHINGTON, D.C., APRIL 28 -- Rep. Gerry E. Studds, D-Mass., will host a one day Federal Procurement Conference for 12th Congressional District businessmen May 11, 1976, at Dunfey's in Hyannis.

Advance registration for the conference which will bring local businessmen together with government military and civilian procurement experts and a number of prime civilian contractors has been heavy. The conference is being co-sponsored by the South Shore and Greater Plymouth Chambers of Commerce, the Greater New Bedford Chamber of Commerce and the Cape Cod Chamber of Commerce.

"Our goal is to make available to local businessmen the information and procedures they need to sell their products or services to the U.S. government and to its prime contractors, as well as to inform them of existing opportunities for export abroad," Studds said.
