Mr. TSONGAS introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

**A BILL**

For the relief of Andrew L. Lui and his wife, Julia Lui.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3 That, notwithstanding section 212(a)(14) of the Immigration  
4 and Nationality Act, for purposes of such Act, Andrew L.  
5 Lui, and his wife, Julia Lui, shall be held and considered to  
6 have been lawfully admitted to the United States for perma-  
7 nent residence as of the date of the enactment of this Act  
8 upon payment of the required visa fees. Upon the granting of  
9 permanent residence to such aliens as provided for in this  
10 Act, the Secretary of State shall instruct the proper officer to  
11 reduce by the proper number, during the current fiscal year  
12 or the fiscal year next following, the total number of immi-

1 grant visas which are made available to natives of the coun-  
2 try of the aliens' birth under section 203(a) of the Immigra-  
3 tion and Nationality Act or, if applicable, the total number of  
4 immigrant visas which are made available to natives of the  
5 country of the aliens' birth under section 202(e) of such Act.
