## A BILL

For the relief of Andrew L. Lui and his wife, Julia Lui.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 That, notwithstanding section 212(a)(14) of the Immigration
- 4 and Nationality Act, for purposes of such Act, Andrew L.
- 5 Lui, and his wife, Julia Lui, shall be held and considered to
- 6 have been lawfully admitted to the United States for perma-
- 7 nent residence as of the date of the enactment of this Act
- 8 upon payment of the required visa fees. Upon the granting of
- 9 permanent residence to such aliens as provided for in this
- 10 Act, the Secretary of State shall instruct the proper officer to
- 11 reduce by the proper number, during the current fiscal year
- 12 or the fiscal year next following, the total number of immi-

- 1 grant visas which are made available to natives of the coun-
- 2 try of the aliens' birth under section 203(a) of the Immigra-
- 3 tion and Nationality Act or, if applicable, the total number of
- 4 immigrant visas which are made available to natives of the
- 5 country of the aliens' birth under section 202(e) of such Act.
