I'd like to invite you -- and your family -- and your staff and their families to join me in participating in "Everybody's Bike Day," Sunday, October 9, in Rock Creek Park, beginning at 10:00 a.m. and ending at 3:00 p.m.

The event is being planned by the national non-profit Bicycle Federation in cooperation with the Bicycle Manufacturers Association of America. The purpose of the Day is simply to celebrate the joys of bicycling.

Planned activities include:

- a kick-off parade led by government officials and cyclists on high wheel bicycles and unicycles (and regular bikes, too!)

- mini-bicycle tours through the park
- safety clinics, displays and demonstrations.
