A BILL

To amend the Small Business Act to provide that, for purposes of the waiver of the \$500,000 limitation on disaster loans, the owner of a building which contains the principal place of business of at least one-third of the private employers in a downtown business district shall be treated as a major source of employedment.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

- That (a) paragraph (4) of section 7(c) of the Small Business Act is amended by adding at the end thereof the following new sentence:

 "For purposes of the preceding sentence, a person shall be treated as a major source of employment in an area if such person owns a building which has a fair market value before the disaster of at least \$1,000,000 and which contains the principal place of business of at least one-third of the private employers in the downtown buisness district of any city."
- (b) The amendment made by subsection (a) shall apply to disasters occurring on or after January 1, 1982.
