For the relief of Kil Joon Yu Callahan.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 3 That, notwithstanding section 212(a)(23) or any other provision of the Immigration and Nationality Act, in the administration of such Act, Kil Joon Yu Callahan shall be held and 5 considered to have been lawfully admitted to the United States for permanent residence as of the date of the enactment of this Act upon payment of the required visa fee. Upon the granting of permanent residence to such alien as provided 10 for in this Act, the Secretary of State shall instruct the 11 proper officer to reduce by the proper number, during the

current fiscal year or the fiscal year next following, the total

- 1 number of immigrant visas which are made available to na-
- 2 tives of the country of the alien's birth under section 203(a)
- 3 of the Immigration and Nationality Act or, if applicable, the
- 4 total number of immigrant visas which are made available to
- 5 natives of the country of the alien's birth under section
- 6 202(e) of such Act.
