- * The Senate is in recess. Paul is in Massachusetts.
- * A statement by Paul on <u>public housing</u> appears in the April 9 Congressional Record on page S3845.
- * Paul's statement on the Kennedy <u>Gun</u> <u>Control</u> bill, S. 974, appears in the Congressional Record on page, S3815 (Kennedy's statement and the bill are on page S3806).
- * Paul has cosponsored S. 32, a bill to grant a Federal Charter to the Italian American War Veterans of the United States.
- * Paul cosigned a letter dated April 9 to President Reagan on the issue of the Syrian military presence in Lebanon and its attack on the Christian city of Zahlah. The letter urged the President to seek an immediate cease-fire, an end to the Syrian siege of Zahlah, and to encourage the withdrawal of Syrian forces from Labanon. The issue here is the survival of Christian forces in Lebanon and the limitation of excessive Syrian military activities which have transformed their peace-keeping forces into an army of occupation.
- * Senator Percy plans hearings (either April 30 or May 1) in the Governmental Affairs Energy Subcommittee on the role local officials can play in handling severe energy emergencies.
