To amend the Tariff Schedules of the United States to provide for a lower rate of duty for certain fish netting and fish nets.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That subpart C of part 4 of schedule 3 of the Tariff Schedules of the United States (19 U.S.C. 1202) is amended by striking out item 355.45 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

SEC. 2. The amendments made by the first section of this Act shall apply with respect to articles entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption on or after the date of enactment of this Act.
