

KEY PEOPLE IN LEBANON

BASHIR GEMAYEL

- Rightest Christian leader
- Commands Christian Phalange militia called the Lebanese Forces -- at least 25,000 men
- Forces located east of Beirut to the Bekaa Valley and north to Barbarah

WALID JUMBLANT

- Leftist Moslem leader
- Leader of Druze Sect
- Heads leftist coalition called National Movement
- Forces located east of Beirut in the Chouf Mountains of central Lebanon

PIERRE GEMAYEL

- President of Conservative Phalangist Party which is leading party among Christians

ELIAS SARKIS

- Lebanese President
- Christian

SAEB SALAM

- Former Prime Minister of Lebanon (six times)
- Traditional Sunni Moslem leader
- Intermediary between Arafat and U.S. negotiator, Ambassador Habib

NABIH BERRI

- Shiite Moslem leader
- His militia is called Amal and it remains the most powerful force in Lebanese Shiite Society
- Shiites located in southern Lebanon
- Amal was the only Lebanese militia that resisted the Israelis

MAJOR SAAD HADDAD

- Renegade Lebanese Christian Army officer
- Forces located in southern Lebanon along the Israeli border
- Attempting to impose his authority on Shiites located from vicinity of the Israeli border to central Lebanon.
- Commands Israeli-equipped army of about 2,000 men

SAFIK AL-WAZZAN

- Lebanese Prime Minister
- Has been active in negotiations concerning P.L.O. in west Beirut
- Intermediary between Habib and Arafat

FUAD BUTROS

- Lebanese Foreign Minister
- Greek Orthodox
