Pan American will not issue an Air Rhodesia ticket (South African Airways is fully booked.) Although sanctions have been lifted and Air Rhodesia space can be sold by South African Airways and through TWA, Pan American is still a little behind.

As I explained to Chris, the Angola visa awaits us at the airport. They do not issue visas in New York, but all of the necessary information from our passports has been communicated to Luanda.
