Viz:

- 1       On page 48, line 24, after "jurisdictions," delete the
- 2 following through the period on page 49, line 2, and insert in
- 3 lieu thereof the following: "(1) the Secretary shall within
- 4 ninety days after the date of enactment of this title enter into
- 5 an interagency agreement with the Secretary of Housing and
- 6 Urban Development which may provide for the distribution of
- 7 funds or approval of grants by the Secretary of Housing and
- 8 Urban Development as authorized and provided for in this
- 9 title. Such approvals and grants shall be made on the basis of
- 10 rules promulgated by the Secretary in consultation with the

1 Secretary of Housing and Urban Development, or (2) if the  
2 requirements of clause (1) are not met the Secretary, in con-  
3 sultation with the Secretary of Housing and Urban Develop-  
4 ment is authorized to make grants as provided in this title.”.

5 On page 60, line 12, strike subsection (b), and insert the  
6 following in lieu thereof:

7 “(b) The President shall submit a report to the Congress  
8 including any recommendations with regard to the appropri-  
9 ate funding level and administration of a community energy  
10 conservation and renewable energy resource grant program,  
11 which activities should be included as part of such a program,  
12 and any legislative amendment to the existing formula by not  
13 later than nine months after the date of the enactment of this  
14 Act.”.
