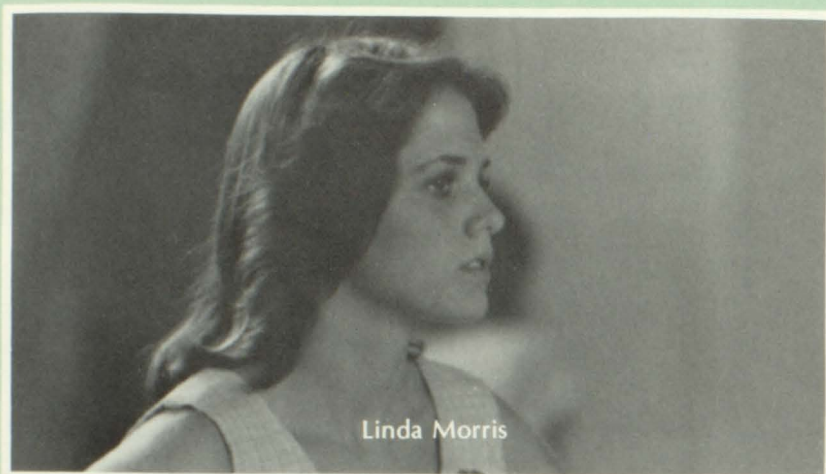


HOMECOMING QUEEN
