NO INDIVIDUAL SCHOOL SHOULD BE REPORTED IN PART BY TWO SCHOOL SYSTEMS.

TABLE I - - The total number of instructional employees (academic and vocational teachers, non-teaching and teaching principals, exceptional children teachers, and other regular program teachers) in each school should be reported in Cols. 1 through 8. The certificates for the personnel listed in Cols. 1 through 8 should be reported in Cols. 9 through 17. The number recorded in Col. 17 should equal the number recorded in Col. 8.

Kindergarten, special adult programs, evening extension, veterans, and O.S.Y. teachers, part and full-time, should be reported in Cols. 18 through 21.
