


Since the first *Aries* was published in 1939, succeeding issues of the *Aries* have portrayed the changes time has brought.





The first faculty section of the *Aries* pictured teachers who, for the most part, have passed on to other schools, or who have simply passed on.








Even the pastimes and activities depicted have assumed new forms and indicate different trends.
