The first faculty section of the *Aries* pictured teachers who, for the most part, have passed on to other schools, or who have simply passed on.

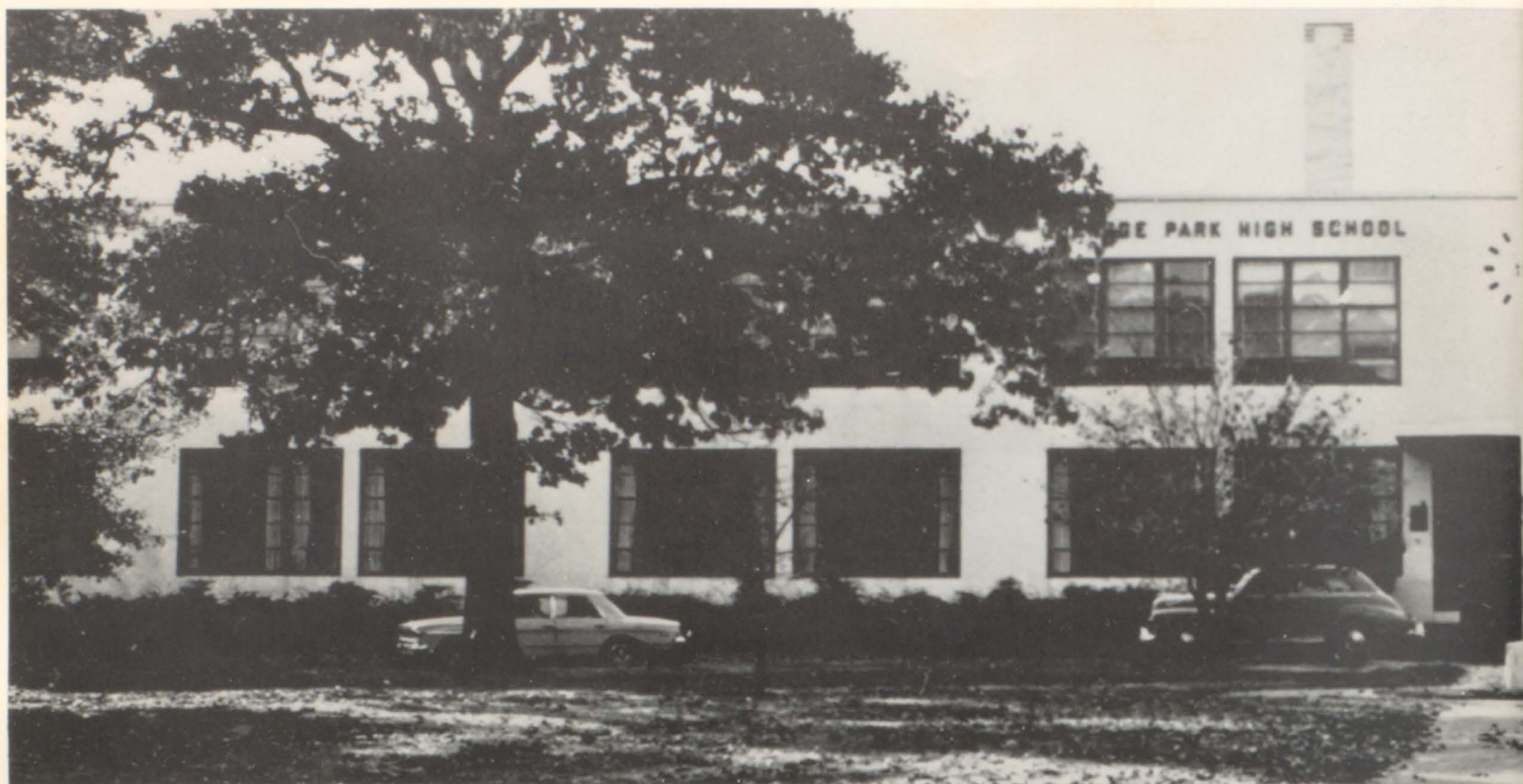




Even the pastimes and activities depicted have assumed new forms and indicate different trends.



Students have come and gone, taking their styles of dress and modes of thought with them.

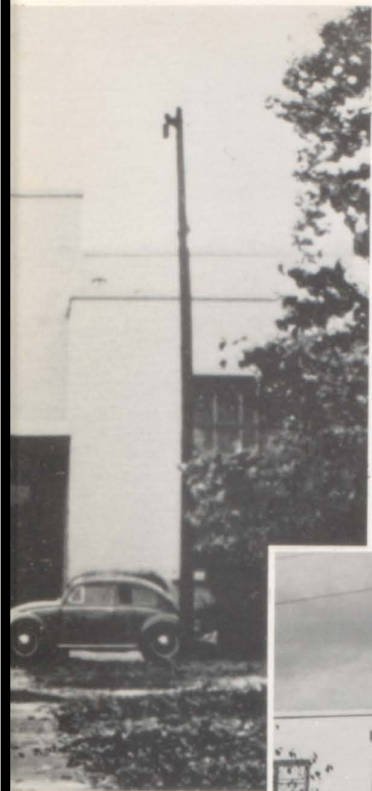


Time has brought changes; it almost always does. However, the effects of time can be resisted.
